

IMPORTANT CAMP INFO

We will be returning to the same location at North Clarendon Baptist Church, 260 North Clarendon Avenue, Scottdale. We are so excited to bring our camps back to DeKalb County this year.

We are combining decorating treats with some sweets-related art!

CAMP CUPCAKE WILL TEACH:

- Measuring, coloring, & mixing buttercream frosting*
- Utensil usage
- Cupcake and sweets decorating (piping styles and skills)
- Fondant coloring, mixing, making shapes and some modeling
- Clay art sweets-themed pieces
- Cupcake Display Plate
- Theme Canvas painting
- Crafts and games

Children will **NOT be touching hot ovens.*

We designed the camp curriculum carefully to work best with the age ranges listed, taking into consideration things like a child's size and manual dexterity. Please follow the age requirements. Camp participants make new sweets and art pieces each day. For older children please understand, unless they are registered for a teen camp, there may be children as young as 7 yrs. old in their camp group. This year our camp themes will include Superhero, Games (Legos, Pokemon, etc.), Harry Potter, Christmas in July, Star Wars, and Intermediate skills.

Every class session includes time for cleaning up, and campers are expected to clean up after themselves!

Some clay items may be left at Camp at the end of the week for kiln-firing. Please bring your child with you to pick up completed work. It is most helpful as your child can more easily identify their own creations. Completed projects will be ready for pick up the week after the camp ends (we will try our best to return them on Friday of the camp week).

Camp participants should wear clothes that can get messy, and closed-toe shoes (old sneakers or crocs are great; *please*, NO flip-flops or sandals).

Lunch/Snack Time

Campers will take a lunch break and two short snack (stretch) breaks. Please pack a lunch, a bottle of water and drinks for the day, as well as two small non-perishable snacks for your child, and be sure to label the bag with their name.

Please do not send food for your children to share with others. Many children have food allergies, and we would not want a medical emergency caused by food sharing. **Please let us know your child's food allergies!** Only siblings may share food.
